Brightline's Basecamp (Vehicle Maintenance Facility) is the most advanced full maintenance train facility in the region, capable of servicing 16 trains daily. Located on 62 acres south of Orlando International Airport, the site includes a fully-automated train wash, an 80K gallon biodiesel fuel farm and maintenance and storage tracks that extend the length of more than two football fields.

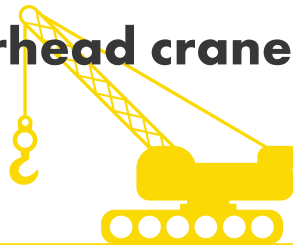
