**Virgin Trains Construction Update:  
Lane Closure and Work Zone Advisory for Orlando Extension  
(Phase 2 - Orlando to South Florida)**

**ORLANDO, FL.** (January 26, 2020) - Virgin Trains, formerly Brightline, announces lane closures and work zone information for Phase 2 construction from Orlando to West Palm Beach, connecting Orlando to South Florida. Motorists should drive with extra caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. **Full closures and high-profile closures are indicated in red.** Railroad construction information can also be found online at <https://www.gobrightline.com/railroad-construction>.

**Orange County**

***Orlando International Airport***

**Eastbound and westbound Cargo Rd. between Bear Rd. and Casa Verde Rd. (north of Orlando International Airport)**

Extended single lane closure in each direction through 2020 for bridge work. One lane will remain open in each direction.

***SR 417 and Beachline Expressway/SR 528***

**Northbound SR 417 exit ramp to eastbound and westbound SR 528 (Exit 26)**

Continuous day-time shoulder closure, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

**Northbound SR 417 exit ramp to eastbound SR 528 (Exit 26)**

Night-time slow roll closure, 3 a.m. to 5 a.m., Thursday, January 30.

Day-time single lane closure, 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday, January 27 through Friday, January 31.

**Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 between Industry Road and I-95 (milepost 44-41)**

Night-time single lane closure, 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Monday, February 10 through Friday, February 21.

**Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR-528 to Northbound I-95 (Exit 42)**

Night-time full ramp closure, Monday, February 10 to Friday, February 21. Closure will occur from 10:00 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday through Thursday and from 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m., Friday night into Saturday morning. Closure is necessary to construct a new off ramp alignment prior to a future traffic shift.

**Detour Information:**

- Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 traffic wishing to access northbound I-95 will be directed to exit at Clearlake Rd. (Exit 45A), travel south on Industry Rd. to SR 524 and travel west on SR 524 to access northbound I-95.

#### **Northbound I-95 exit ramp to Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 205)**

Night-time pacing operation, 11:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 28 to 5 a.m., Wednesday, January 29 to relocate a crane. *If necessary, to complete the work, closure will also occur 11:30 p.m., Thursday, January 30 to 5 a.m., Friday, January 31.*

### ***Railroad Crossings***

#### **Melbourne – Railroad Crossings from Post Rd. to Nasa Blvd.**

Day-time periodic closures and flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Tuesday, January 28 through Thursday, January 30 for delivery of train rails. *Potential crossings impacted: Parkway Dr., Lake Washington Rd., Masterson St., Aurora Rd., Babcock St., and Nasa Blvd. Crossings may be closed intermittently for periods of 10-15 minutes to allow for rails to be unloaded and will reopen to allow traffic to pass.*

#### **Sebastian – Railroad Crossing at Barefoot Blvd.**

Day-time median closure, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday, February 3.
